Notes: ¹ A [pictograph](#) is a pictorial sign or symbol. Hieroglyphs are *Egyptian* pictographs. A *glyph* is an element of writing. ² [Transliteration](#) is the process of *mapping* letters from one alphabet into another alphabet using *graphology* (letter-shapes) & *history* (see [Evolution of the English Alphabet Chart](#) & [The True Hebrew Alphabet Family Tree](#)). ³ [Transcription](#) is the process of *matching* the *sounds* of human speech to letters (see [The Sound of Ancient Hebrew](#) & [Ancient Hebrew—the First Text Language](#)). ⁴ with default “a” added when needed—which is usually between 2 consonants in Ancient Hebrew. ⁵ ð & ʃ are [Old English](#) (mid 5thC—mid 12thC) & [Middle English](#) (late 11thC— ~ 1470) letters. ⁶ as in the Scottish “loch”. ⁷ as said in Modern Jewish Hebrew, Syriac Aramaic & Arabic.
